FAQ Adura LOCnGO

1. What is Adura LOCnGO?

Adura LOCnGO is a collection of luxury vinyl planks that have pre-applied adhesive tabs that is installed as a "Floating Floor." All of the current Mannington Adura Luxury Flooring planks, both 4" and 5" wide are available as either fully adhered or LOCnGO construction.

2. Is there any pad or underlayment required under Adura LOCnGO?

No, Adura LOCnGO can be installed directly over all structurally sound, clean, dry and smooth subfloor systems. Most hard surface existing floors that can be rendered smooth are suitable for use under Adura LOCnGO.

3. Can anything (kitchen cabinets, islands, knee walls, etc.) be fastened into or installed on top of the Adura LOCnGO?

No, Adura LOCnGO is installed as a "floating floor" in that it is not secured to the subfloor. Do not install anything on top of or fasten through the flooring system.

4. Can heavy furniture (pool tables, pianos, etc) or heavy appliances (Refrigerators, freezer, etc) be placed on top of the Adura LOCnGO?

Yes, these items are not fastened through the flooring system but rather sit on top. Heavy items will probably produce indentations in the flooring system if left in contact for extended periods.

5. Can Adura LOCnGO be installed in commercial settings?

Adura LOCnGO has a five year LIGHT Commercial warrant. This "floating floor" is not intended for heavy rolling loads, extreme foot trafficking or heavy commercial maintenance procedures.

6. Can Adura LOCnGO planks be combined with Adura fully adhered tiles?

No, different installation systems would be problematic; Adura planks are available in both "floating" and fully adhered constructions.

7. Is there a maximum length or "run" like with laminate panels for Adura LOCnGO?

Adura LOCnGO is primarily a residential flooring product or LIGHT commercial; the maximum run is greater than any dimensions encountered in these settings.

8. What is the proper amount of stagger or offset for the end seams with LOCnGO planks?

The same as with standard Adura plank 6" to 8" in a random, staggered pattern; as with all plank products work from several cartons at one time.

9. How many times can the adhesive tabs be removed and repositioned?

During installation the adhesive tabs can be lifted to re-position the plank two or three times with no degradation to the adhesive strength. The longer the adhesive tabs are in contact with each other the more tenacious the bond becomes. .

10. Can Adura LOCnGO be installed in an area with direct sunlight exposure?

No, all finished floor covering is adversely affected by direct exposure to the extreme heat and UV exposure. Use window coverings to diffuse direct sunlight.

11. Can a single plank replacement be done in the event one is damaged?

Yes, it is a straightforward replacement technique requiring only the use of a sharp utility knife. Use a strip of waxed paper between the "under- adhesive" tab of the repair plank to keep it from bonding to the "over-adhesive" tab on the adjoining plank.
